



Direct representation Private person - Value over 10 000 SEK

Pursuant to [EU Regulation No 952/2013](#) of the European Parliament and of the Council, the customs rules set out in Article 19 of the European Union Customs Code obligates DB Schenker, when acting as a direct customs agent (ie. acting in the name of and on behalf of another person), to obtain your power of attorney to customs declare your goods.

Obtaining a power of attorney is a requirement from the Swedish Customs Authority in order for DB Schenker to carry out a customs declaration of your goods. The power of attorney is needed regardless of the value of the goods. If the value of the goods exceeds SEK 10,000, the Swedish Customs Authority also requires that the importer's private individual's social security number shall be stated on the customs declaration.

The power of attorney applies to import declarations in Sweden. Please make sure we have the correct name and social security number before checking the box below.
